

1. SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- This ladder should be treated as an addition to, not a replacement for, existing fire precautions.
- DO NOT use for any other purpose other than as an emergency escape ladder.
- DO NOT undo securing strap to release rungs unless needed in an emrgency situation.
- DO NOT exceed maximum load on ladder.
- Ensure that your intended landing area is clear of bushes etc and reasonably level.
- Ensure that you, and all members of the household, are thoroughly familiar with the deployment instructions.
- Keep in an easily accessible location close to an upstairs window, but not a location accessible to children.
- Include emergency escape ladder in a pre-formulated escape plan.
- Check for obstructions such as power cables or telphone wires in the area of the intended escape window.
- May not be suitable for those with limited mobility.
- Minimum window width: 410mm (16")
- Maximum wall thickness below window sill: 345mm (131/2")

2. INTRODUCTION

- Lightweight emergency escape ladder.
- Fitted with window hooks for placement over window sills.
- Maximum capacity of 450kg.
- Compact unit is secured with a hook and loop strap which is pulled to unfurl the rungs when in use.
- Fitted with durable anti-slip metal rungs and fire resistant nylon straps.
- Designed for quick and easy use.
- Conforms to EN 131.







4. INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE





Original Language Version **EEL01**, **EEL02** Issue: 1 - 30/11/12

- DO NOT UNPACK LADDER RUNGS EXCEPT IN AN EMERGENCY.
- Open red attachment hooks and spread centre brace (Fig.2).
- Place hooks over window sill with attachment for ladder to the outside (fig.3)
- With ladder pack outside pull the hook and loop fastening on the black webbing, thereby releasing the rungs. (Figs. 3 & 4)
- The ladder is now ready for use (Fig.5) Climb through window, holding on to support hooks to steady oneself.
- 4.5. When descending, keep body close to rungs for greatest stability.
- Grip rungs with both hands during descent.


