1. SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

1.1. GENERAL.

- ✓ Ensure the penlight is correctly charged before initial use.
- ✗ **DO NOT** turn the light on when it is being re-charged.
- ✗ **DO NOT** shine directly into your, other person's or animal's eyes.
- ✗ **DO NOT** allow children to use the penlight.
- ✗ **DO NOT** use the penlight if you suspect that the battery or the penlight casing is damaged.
- ✗ **DO NOT** immerse the penlight in water.
- ✓ When not in use store the penlight in a safe, dry, childproof location.

1.2. ELECTRICAL SAFETY.

USE ONLY THE SUPPLIED MAINS CHARGER PLUG FOR CONNECTING TO THE MAINS POWER SUPPLY.

- ☐ **WARNING!** It is the user's responsibility to read, understand and comply with the following electrical instructions: You must ensure the risk of electric shock is minimised by the installation of appropriate safety devices. An RCCB (Residual Current Circuit Breaker) should be incorporated in the main distribution board. We also recommend that an RCD (Residual Current Device) is used with all electrical products, particularly portable equipment which is plugged into an electrical supply not protected by an RCCB. **You must** also read and understand the following instructions concerning electrical safety.

 - ✗ **DO NOT** get the charger wet, or use in wet, damp conditions (for indoor use only).

2. INTRODUCTION & SPECIFICATION

Small, compact design is ideal for keeping in pocket. Features 6 super bright LEDs. 5 SMDs (Surface Mount Devices) for use as an inspection lamp and 1 ultra bright 3W CREE in top for use as a directional torch. Push on/off button on front of casing. Rechargeable Lithium-ion battery for extra-long use. Supplied with USB lead and mains charger.

3. OPERATION

3.1. OPERATION

- ☐ **WARNING!** Ensure that you read, and fully understand the safety instructions before use.
- 3.1.2. Charge the battery before use.
IMPORTANT: Ensure the light is turned 'Off' whilst charging. Failure to do so will damage the charger plug.
- 3.1.3. The penlight can be charged from either the mains adaptor or from a computer via the USB cable; the charging jack is connected into the charging port in the base.
- 3.1.3. A full charge takes approximately 4 hours, allowing up to 4 hours of use.
- 3.1.4. Whilst charging, a red LED shows in the SMD display; a green LED shows when charged.
- 3.1.5. As this light is fitted with a lithium-ion battery, it can be charged at any time; there is no 'memory' effect with this type of battery.
- 3.1.6. The first press of the switch (fig.1) illuminates the CREE LED in the end, the second press lights the SMD's arranged on the front of the unit. **WARNING:** Ensure that the penlight is pointing away from you before operating the switch.

Environmental Protection.
