
2. INTRODUCTION

Double-sided rack for safe and tidy workshop storage of painted bumpers. Prevents inadvertent damage to paint finish during storage. Four pairs of height adjustable support arms for maximum capacity and flexibility. Fitted with four castors, two with brake, for maximum manoeuvrability and safe positioning.

3. ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Refer to diagram overleaf.

- 3.1. Lay T plate (9), (smooth side down) under each end of base tube (1).
- 3.2. Lay end base tubes (6) perpendicular to base tube (1).
- Place vertical tube (8) onto the top of each of the ends of the base tube 3.3.
- Use four screws (7), washers (21) nuts (20) to bolt the three tubes, of 3.4. each end, together,
- Put two long cross tubes (12) onto each lower vertical tube (8) and secure 3.5 with knob (11).
- Place the handle tube (10) over one of the lower vertical tubes (8) and 3.6. secure with knob (11).
- 3.7. Insert the upper vertical tubes (14) into the lower vertical tubes (8).
- Insert screw (19) through the hole in each upright tube (8 & 14) and fix 3.8. circle tube (17) between them.
- Put two short cross tubes (15) onto each of the upper vertical tubes (14) 3.9. and secure with knobs (11).
- 3.10. Place circle tube (17) between the upper vertical tubes and use screw (19) to fix circle tube between them.
- 3.11. Fix on castors (5) ensuring that braked ones go onto one end.
- Fit long foam (13) and short foam (16) covers onto their respective cross 3.12. tubes.
- 3.13. Fit end plugs (18) into the end of each cross tube.
