

SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- Ensure axle stands are in good order and condition. DO NOT use if damaged. ./
- When centre column has been inserted into stand ensure the locking tab (fig.1) is bent inward to stop the column from coming out.
- Apply vehicle handbrake and chock wheels before jacking and using stands (put automatics in 'Park') 1
- Raise centre column of stand and ensure the centre of the saddle is located under vehicle jacking point. Refer to vehicle handbook for jacking 1 points
- Ensure the centre column is locked with the locking lever down and pawl engaged with a ratchet tooth (fig.2). ./
- DANGER! Great care must be taken to ensure you lower the vehicle slowly and carefully onto the centres of the axle stands.
- Ensure that vehicle and stands are stable before starting work. ./
- DO NOT use on soft ground or tarmacadam. Use on concrete only. x
- **DO NOT** use single stand. Only use in pairs. X
 - DO NOT support more than the maximum capacity, as written on the axle stand (i.e. 3 Tonnes each, 6 Tonnes per pair).
- DO NOT use four stands on one vehicle. x
- DO NOT iack one end of vehicle if the other end is already on stands or the load will topple. x

INSTRUCTIONS MAY RESULT IN DAMAGE TO THE AXLE STANDS, LOSS OF LOAD, RESULTING

- DO NOT use for three wheeled vehicles or trailers. Refer to manufacturer's instructions. X
- DO NOT use stands if damaged. X



SPECIFICATION 2.

IN PROPERTY DAMAGE, SERIOUS PERSONAL INJURY, OR LOSS OF LIFE.

BEFORE FIRST USE 3.

- Insert centre column into base of stand (fig.2). 3.1
- Ensure toothed side of column will engage with locking lever mechanism. Bend in locking tab using a small chisel and hammer (fig.1). 3.2.
- 3.3. Check stand is in good condition and has not suffered damage during transit.

OPERATION 4

- 4.1. Refer to vehicle handbook for correct jacking procedure. Check to ensure manufacturer's recommended jacking points are in good condition.
- Position stands under jacking points. 4.2.
- To adjust stands: Hold control lever up while lifting column to required 4.3. height. Push control lever down to lock pawl into column teeth (fig.2). WARNING! ENSURE PAWL IS FULLY ENGAGED WITH TEETH.
- 4.4. Carefully and slowly lower vehicle onto stands. Ensure load bearing points sit in the centre of the saddles and that the stands are stable.
- DANGER! You must follow instructions carefully and ensure you DO NOT load the stands off centre. Failure to heed these warnings may cause damage, injury or loss of life!

MAINTENANCE & INSPECTION 5.

- 5.1. Before each use, check that stands and stand welds are not cracked and that there are no missing or damaged parts. Any suspect axle stands must be removed from service immediately.
- 5.2. Due to the potential hazards associated with stands, do not misuse, or make any modification to, the stands or components.
- It is the responsibility of the owner to ensure that the operator has read these instructions together with the safety features on the 5.3. side of the stand and that the operator is familiar with the stand's use and limitations.
