
- To be installed and disassembled by a responsible adult. Keep plastic bags out of reach from children.

- Site on a firm level surface, adjacent to a mains supply but away from heat sources, doors and walkways.
- DO NOT remove lamps, they cannot be replaced. X
- DO NOT connect to the mains supply whilst the tree is packaged or partially assembled.
- DO NOT over decorate (overload).
- Decorate evenly to maintain balance. Additional stability to base is acceptable and at the users discretion.
- DANGER! Absolutely no modification or maintenance to lights, electrical cable or mains adaptor should be attempted.


2. INTRODUCTION

Pre-lit Colorado pine Christmas tree. Fitted with warm white LED bulbs. Supplied with metal stand. Suitable for indoor use only.



- Note! All models have a top and bottom tree section with one joint, some larger models have 3 sections and 2 joints. 4.1.
- Remove all packaging carefully. You may decide to return the components to the packaging for storage. 411
- Splay open the base stand feet (fig.1) and secure to the base section of the tree with the supplied eye bolts (fig.1). 4.1.2.
- Carefully insert the largest bottom branch section into the base pole. Continue inserting branch sections in descending size order, 4.1.3. leaving the shortest branches for the top (fig.2). Insert the plug into cable sockets and pole connections as you go.
- As you assemble your tree, the branches will fall into place (fig.3). Take care not to place unnecessary pressure on the brackets. 414
- The branches on your tree can be adjusted to give you the desired fullness. For best results, straighten and separate all branch tips, 4.1.5. then bend them slightly upward as in fig.4.
- Plug the 230V adaptor into the mains supply and switch on. Switch off when unattended. 4.1.6.
- 4.1.7. Disassemble in reverse order after use and store (packaged) in a cool dry environment.
